При цьому в числівниках five i twelve -ve змінюсться на f: five- fifth.
До числівника eight, як і до інших, додається при вимові звук [Ө], а на письмі - лише одна буква h: eight - eighth.
У числівнику nine перед суфіксом -th буква е опускається: nine - ninth.
У назвах десятків перед суфіксом -ty буква у змінюється на ie: sixty sixtieth.
Кількісним числівникам від 1 до 3 відповідають такі порядкові числівники: one - first, two - second, three - third.
У складених порядкових числівниках, як і в українській мові, форму порядкового числівника має лише останнє слово: twenty-one - twentyfirst.
